Role of students

- ✓ Camera not switching on [observation a set of students are not switching on their cameras even after repeatedly instructing them; usual answers from the students – low bandwidth]
- ✓ Dress we are not insisting on school uniform but the children should put on a proper attire
- ✓ Assignments non-submission [observation few students have not yet registered with Google Classroom; many students are not submitting their work and even if they are submitting it's without their names]
- ✓ Attendance few are joining late and leaving the class midway; few
 are selective in attending their classes

Role of Teachers

√ Camera – need to monitor the students who are not switching on their cameras;

low bandwidth is an issue and has to be accepted;

there are students those who enter the class, keep their devices on and after that they get engaged with other important works (non-academic);

Co-teachers will have to monitor these students; must communicate with the subject teacher through chat box;

Subject teachers may take a break for few minutes, half way through the class, to deal with the issues

- ✓ Assignments list of students not submitting their assignments are to be published in the class group by individual subject teachers; parents are to be communicated in case of submission of assignments not in the name of the students [office will help you in identifying the child]
- ✓ Attendance share few minutes with the children before you start of the class; greet the children; ask them about their health and their family members; encourage them to remain safe and secured; with regard to attendance be strict but do not be rigid; be polite with the children; permit the children to join the class

- ✓ As mentioned earlier Co-teachers will have to play an active role in the class.
- ✓ While posting study materials, worksheets and assignments in the Google Classroom please make it sure that you are posting them in the correct domain; indexing of study materials, worksheets and assignments is very
 - important
- ✓ As part of Continuous Evaluation tests are to be conducted at the end of one or a couple of chapters and a record has to be kept of the same.
 HODs are to be briefed about the progress of syllabus and the number of tests conducted at the end of every month by the subject teachers.
