Modi Public School, Siliguri was established in 2014 by Nangalia Pokarmal Educational Society with a dream to encourage children to give their best in an attempt to realise their dreams. Since its inception, the school has stressed on both scholastic and co-scholastic activities as both the aspects are inseparable. The school justly provides an infrastructure where children can hone their skills in art & craft, dance, music, culinary, games *etc.*

The school has a library with a good collection of books and every year there is an addition in its number as per requirement. The laboratories – computer, physics, chemistry, biology and mathematics, are well-equipped and as per the standard prescribed by the Board. The music, dance, art & craft and culinary studios are also well-equipped.

The school's vision is to work in partnership with the students, parents and the community at large to a create positive and inclusive environment for high quality learning and teaching where everyone is valued and respected.

The mission of the school is to provide equal opportunity to the children to hone their skills. To retain smiles on their faces, to develop a mind that is curious and inquisitive and a sensitivity that makes them humane in thought, word and deed. The focus is on "learning beyond the classroom".

The institution has a clear understanding of the present-day scenario and every care is taken to provide an environment to the students where they can learn without any fear and restrictions. The school is highly sensitive towards gender issues and takes utmost care so that no form of discrimination exists in the school campus.

The resources available with the school collected through fees takes care of the needs of the school - be it the salaries of the staff or upgrading the infrastructure of the school. The Trust, is benevolent towards the motto of spreading knowledge and as per the budget plan prepared by the SMC, funds projects wherever needed.

The school has classes from 1 to 12. The subjects covered at different grades are –

- a) 1 & 2 : Two languages – English & Hindi / Bengali / Nepali, Mathematics, EVS, ICT, Art Education, Games;
- b) 3 : Two languages – English & Hindi / Bengali / Nepali, Mathematics, EVS, ICT, G.K., Art Education, Games;
- c) 4 & 5 : Two languages – English & Hindi / Bengali / Nepali, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, ICT, G.K., Art Education, Games;
- d) 6, 7 & 8 : Two languages – English & Hindi / Bengali / Nepali, Third language – Hindi / Bengali, Mathematics, Social Science, Science, ICT, G.K., Art Education, Games;
- e) 9 & 10 : Two languages – English & Hindi / Bengali / Nepali, Mathematics, Social Science, Science, Artificial Intelligence, Art Education, Games;
- f) 11 : English Core, English Elective, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Physical Education, History, Geography, Political Science, Artificial Intelligence, Games;
- g) 12 : English Core, English Elective, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Physical Education, History, Geography, Political Science, Games.

The distribution of classes for each scholastic subject is based on modules prescribed from time to time by the Board. Due weightage has been given to dance, music, art & craft, culinary and games. While distributing the classes every care is being taken to see to it that languages – first and second and mathematics are conducted every day.

The syllabus of the different subjects for the different classes have been fragmented in such a way that the students learn at their own pace and are in a position to comprehend the essence of the subjects at the end of the year. Syllabus of different classes for 2020-21 have been uploaded on Google Classroom as well as on school's website.

“Know Your Aptitude” test, introduced by the Board for the students of senior classes in order to guide the students and parents with respect to course of streams or selection of subjects at +2 level, was conducted. The KYA test conducted in the last academic session for the students of Class 10 helped not only the school but also the parents and students in taking a positive approach towards the individual strengths and weaknesses as revealed by the assessments.

The school's Health Unit took care of the health and hygiene of the students on a day to day basis. Regular health check-up in the form of eye, dental care etc. were done during the year 2019-20. This year the focus will be on general hygiene and identifying students suffering from eating disorders if the situation normalises.

The school's Health & Wellness Teacher takes care of the mental health and behavioural issues of the children and guides them in consultation with their parents, wherever needed. The school has implemented the Awakened Citizen's Programme of Ramkrishna Mission in Classes 7 & 8. The response of the students is positive and the Resource Persons of the Mission are very supportive.

Co-curricular activities are an integral part of the school and the school takes utmost care to involve each and every child in different activities which are conducted throughout the year. Be it dance, song, games or elocution, all are encouraged to participate so that the children overcome stage fear and develop confidence. Different activities based on different themes have been prepared for the students of classes 1 to 3. For classes 4 upwards different competitions among the four houses of the school have been arranged. Along with this the different houses will also present morning assemblies based on different themes. They will also display wall magazines based on allotted themes.

To implement the year-long activities during 2020-21, the Principal will meet the academic coordinators and head of the departments on a monthly basis to take stock of the progress and propose corrective measures, if any, in case of any lacunae. The head of the departments will meet their team members on a fortnightly basis and report the same to the academic coordinators. The Principal will meet the entire faculty bi-monthly to guide the teachers with respect to the progress of the pedagogical plan of the school based on the reports received from the academic coordinators and head of the departments.

The continuous and comprehensive engagement with the students, teachers and parents will definitely bring out the desired outcomes.

Teachers' Training

For the last 4 years the school in association with Siliguri B.Ed. College, Shivmandir, Siliguri, is imparting training to the teachers so that the teachers update themselves with the latest pattern of teaching methodologies. In addition to this the teachers of the school are also attending Capacity Building Programmes conducted by the Centre of Excellence, Bhubaneswar. During the current academic session, the teachers will once again be trained in the month of December. The training will be imparted by the experienced teachers of Siliguri B.Ed. College.

Academic achievement

39 candidates appeared for CBSE Class 10 Examination in the month of March 2020. Seven students achieved 90%+ with Subham Chand scoring the highest percentage *i.e.* 95.4%. [477 out 500]. The overall performance of the students was 77.2% which is less than the performance of the students for the year 2019 [88.1%]. The performance in mathematics and science was not satisfactory and steps have been taken to improve the standard of the students in the two subjects in the coming years.

Environmental Education

Starting from planting of trees to enacting of skits on the stage, various programmes were taken up to enlighten the students about sustainable development and its advantages. A programme was held by Dainik Jagran, a Hindi newspaper, for the students to make them understand the importance of water in our life and for the survival of the earth. The students took a pledge to save water in whatever way they could and carry forward the awareness campaign to save water. The pledge to reduce the use of plastic in our daily life has been taken up seriously and the students promised that by the end of the academic session 2020-21 they will make their school plastic-free. The school on its part did away with the use of plastic cups, plates, spoons and water bottles and replaced them with alternatives like paper plates and cups and reuse of glass sauce bottles as water bottles. The use of plastic book wrappers has also been done away with and the parents are being encouraged to use either brown paper or newspaper to cover books or copies. On the food front the parents are being encouraged to send home made foods with a mix of vegetables and fruits in the tiffin box of their wards. The PTA meetings have helped in making it possible.

Sports Achievement

Modi Public School, Siliguri hosted the 6th North Bengal Sahodaya School Complex Inter School Badminton Tournament 2019-20 on 18.01.2020. The performance of our students was excellent. In the Girls Individual category Shabnam Parveen was the winner and in the Girls Team category Shabnam Parveen and Anuska Das were the winners.

Abhimanyu Kumar, Esha Nayak, Brinda Kumari, Sreoshee Mallick and Ravi Kumar Singh participated in the East Zone CBSE School Games.

Parent Teacher Activities

Parent Teacher Meetings are an integral part of the school. It is just not the designated dates on the which the parents and teachers meet, the school also makes arrangement to have one-to-one interaction with the parents during the course of the year to apprise them about the progress of their child with respect to scholastic and co-scholastic activities. The common platform helps the teachers to understand the problems faced by the parents and the parents in turn try to understand the efforts being made by the teachers to make the learning environment an enjoyable one.

Role of SMC

The members of the SMC agreed to develop the infrastructure with respect to AV facilities in the classrooms. It was decided that all the classrooms will have whiteboards along with projectors to make the teaching-learning process an interactive one. The members suggested that the teachers should be trained for optimal use of the AV devices in the classrooms. The members also proposed to build up a playing area exclusively for students of classes 1 to 3.
